




Secret #4: tools

Community design patterns

- Adoption: easy registration, RSS feeds, documentation
- Identity: profiles, avatars, buddy lists, contacts
- Group support: issue queues, trackers, activity streams, reputation
- <u>Conversations:</u> messaging, comments, forums, blogs, interest groups, planet / aggregator
- <u>Development</u>: CVS/SVN, issue queues, release management






