

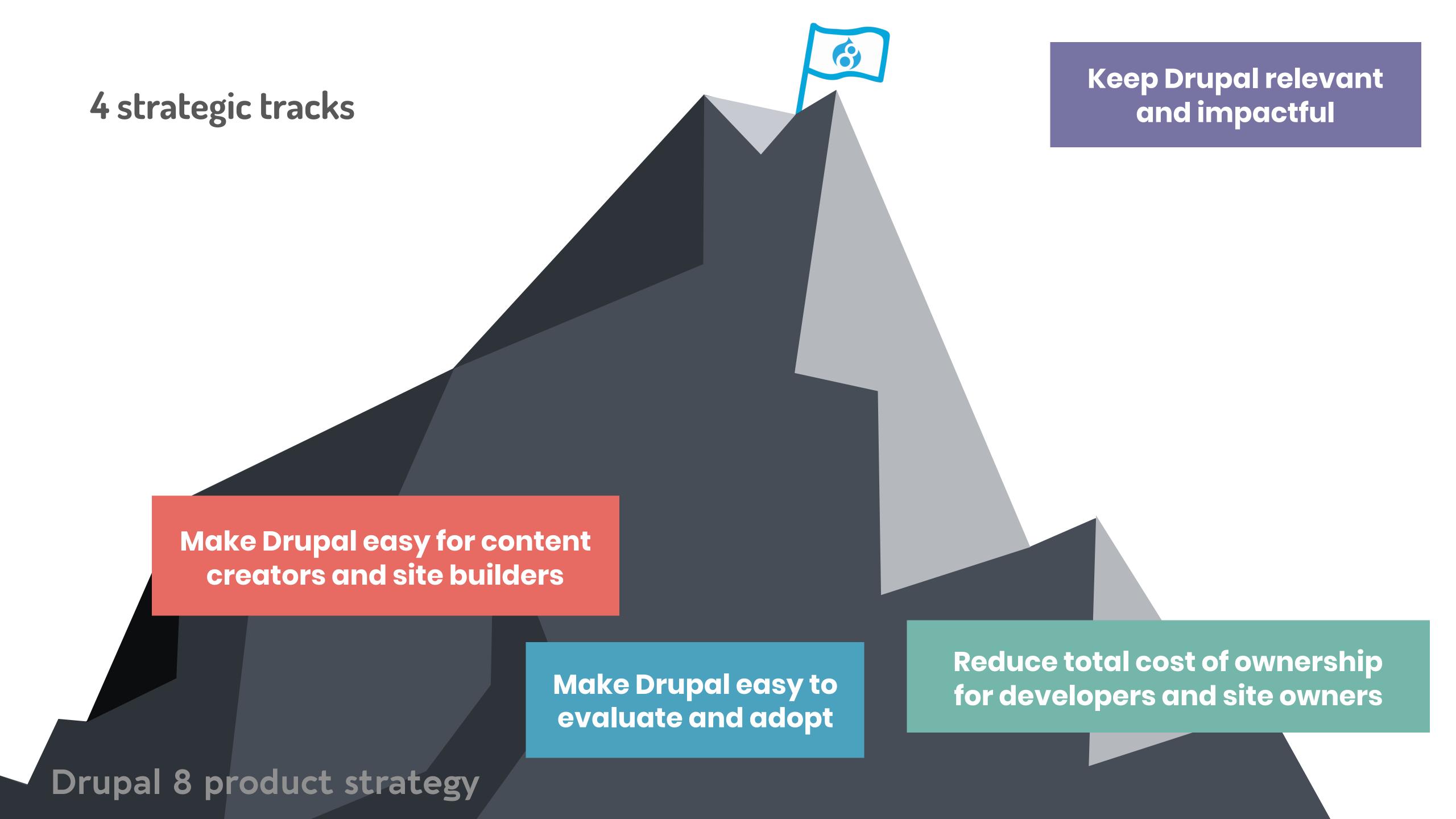

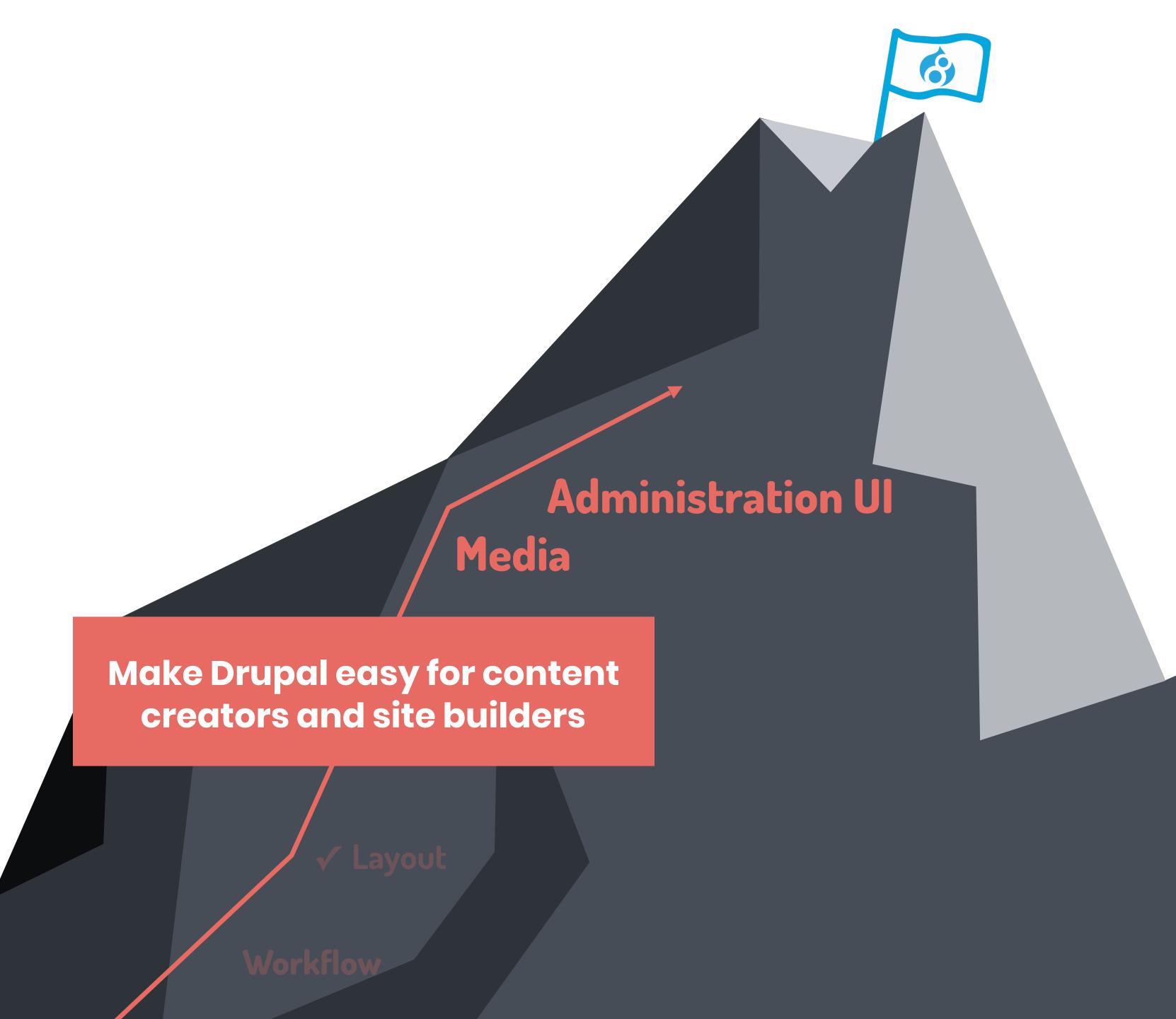

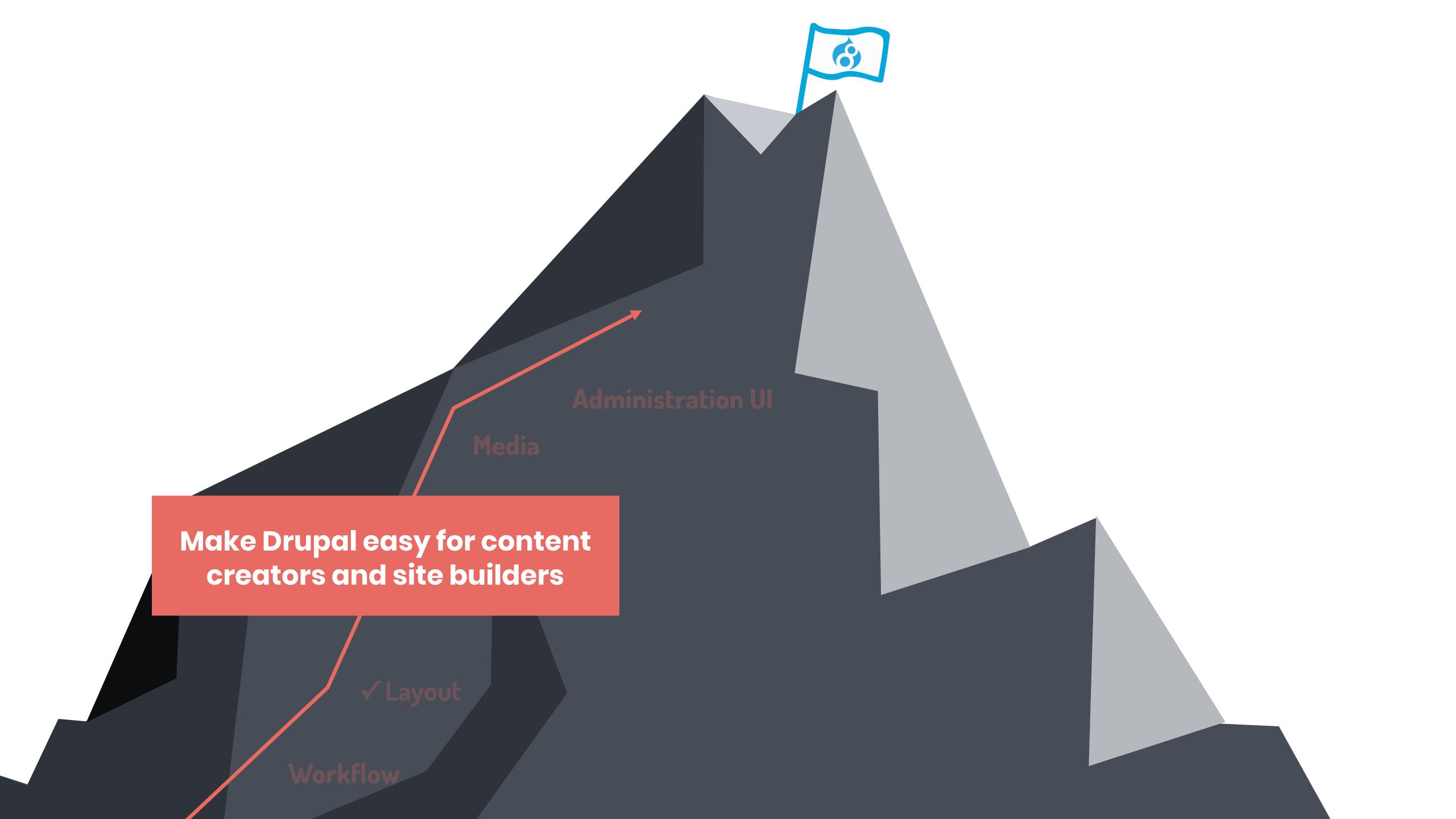

Composer

Why Composer?

It's hard to update everything on your site:

- You may not know everything that needs to be updated (e.g. 3rd party code)
- Module A v2 may not work with Module B v2

It's Composer's job to sort that all out for you.

Drupal's Composer support could be better

Today, managing Drupal via Composer requires contrib packages or custom solutions.

Not officially supported Need for 3rd party tools

Poor Drupal.org integration

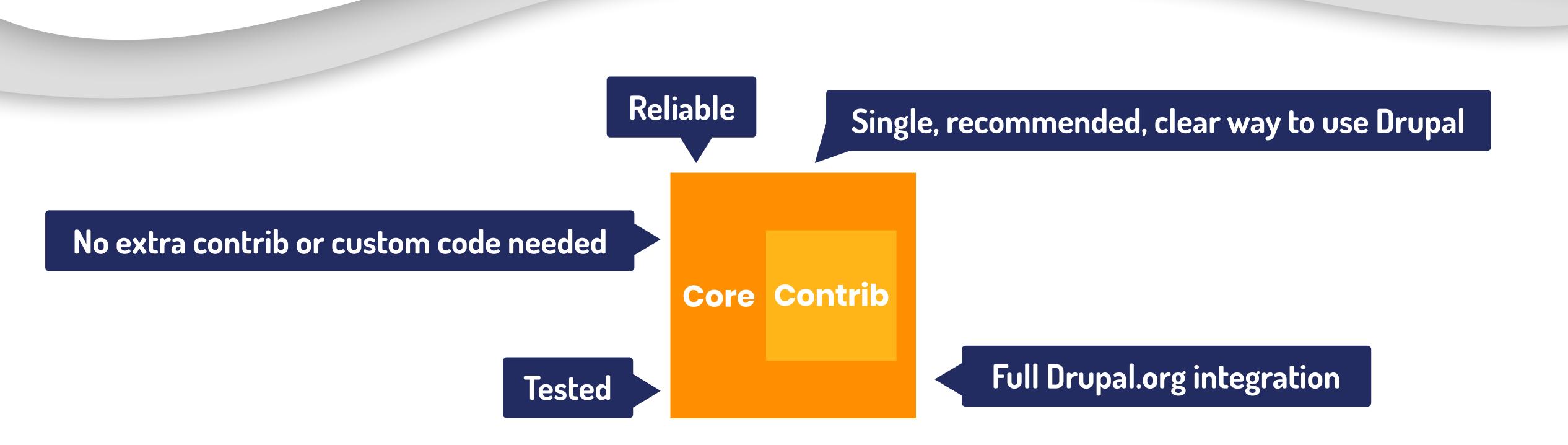

We improved out-of-the-box Composer support



Install or update Drupal in 1 step!

Install Drupal in 1 step:

\$ composer --no-interaction create-project drupal/recommended-project:^8.8 my-project

Update Drupal in 1 step:

\$ composer update drupal/core-recommended --with-all-dependencies



But what if I don't want to use Composer?

Tarballs are still supported (and Composer-ready tarballs are coming soon)

Install Drupal in 1 step:

\$ composer --no-interaction create-project drupal/recommended-project:^8.8 my-project

Update Drupal in 1 step:

\$ composer update drupal/core-recommended --with-all-dependencies

Drupal will upgrade itself automatically

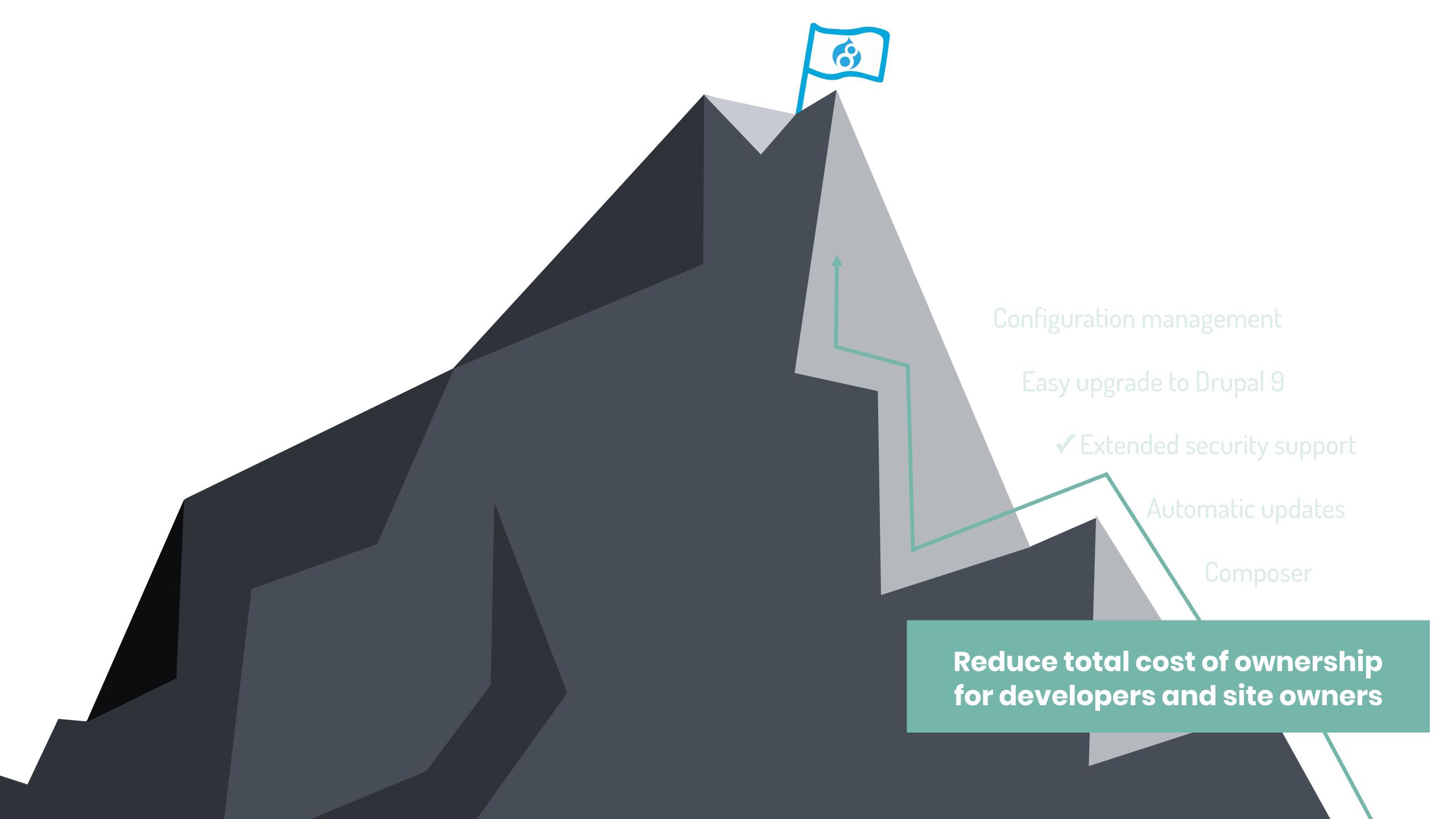

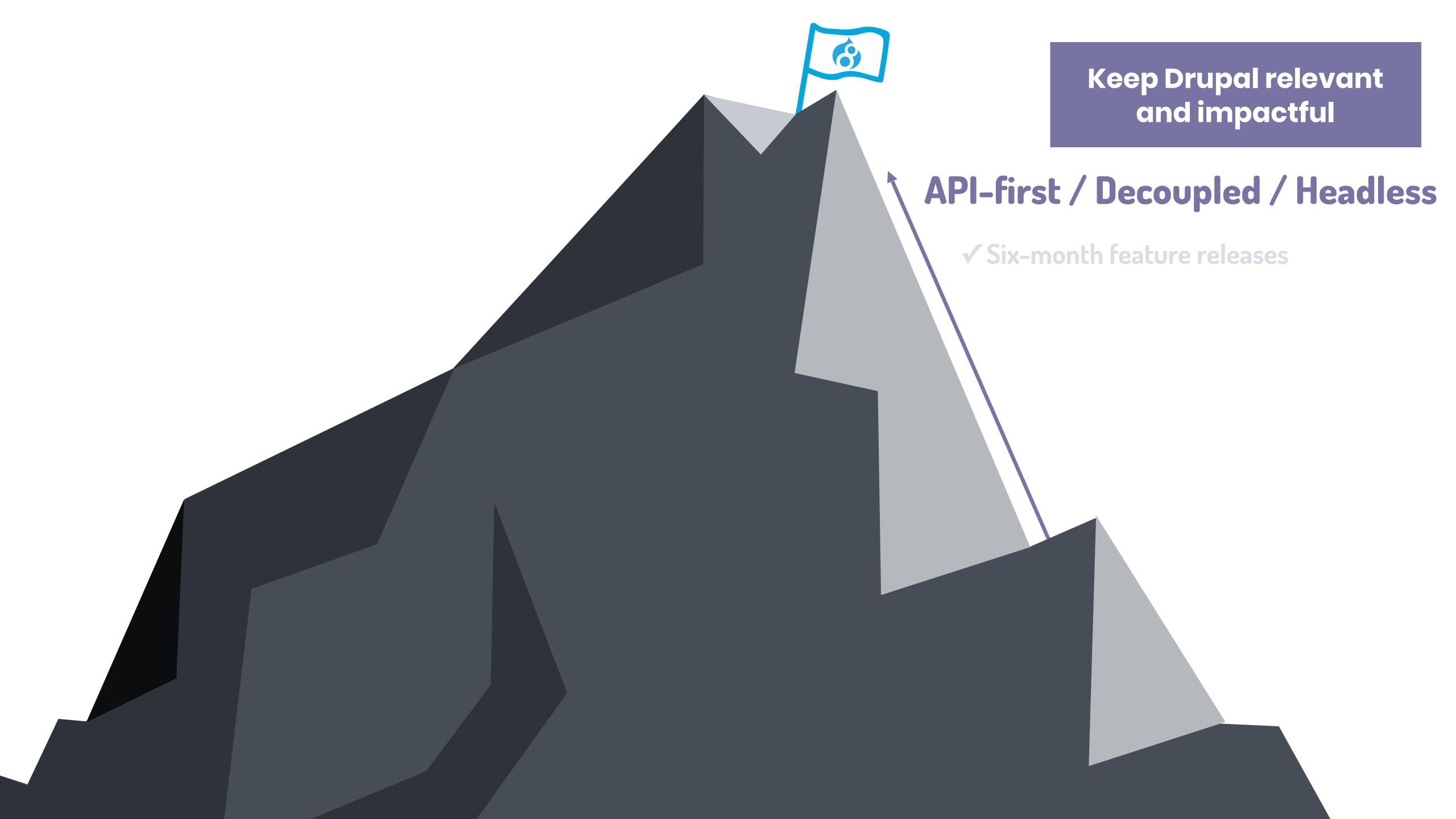


The most advanced built-in deployment tools in Drupal's history

Configuration management

- Exclude modules from configuration synchronization (e.g. development modules)
- API support for configuration transformation on import/export

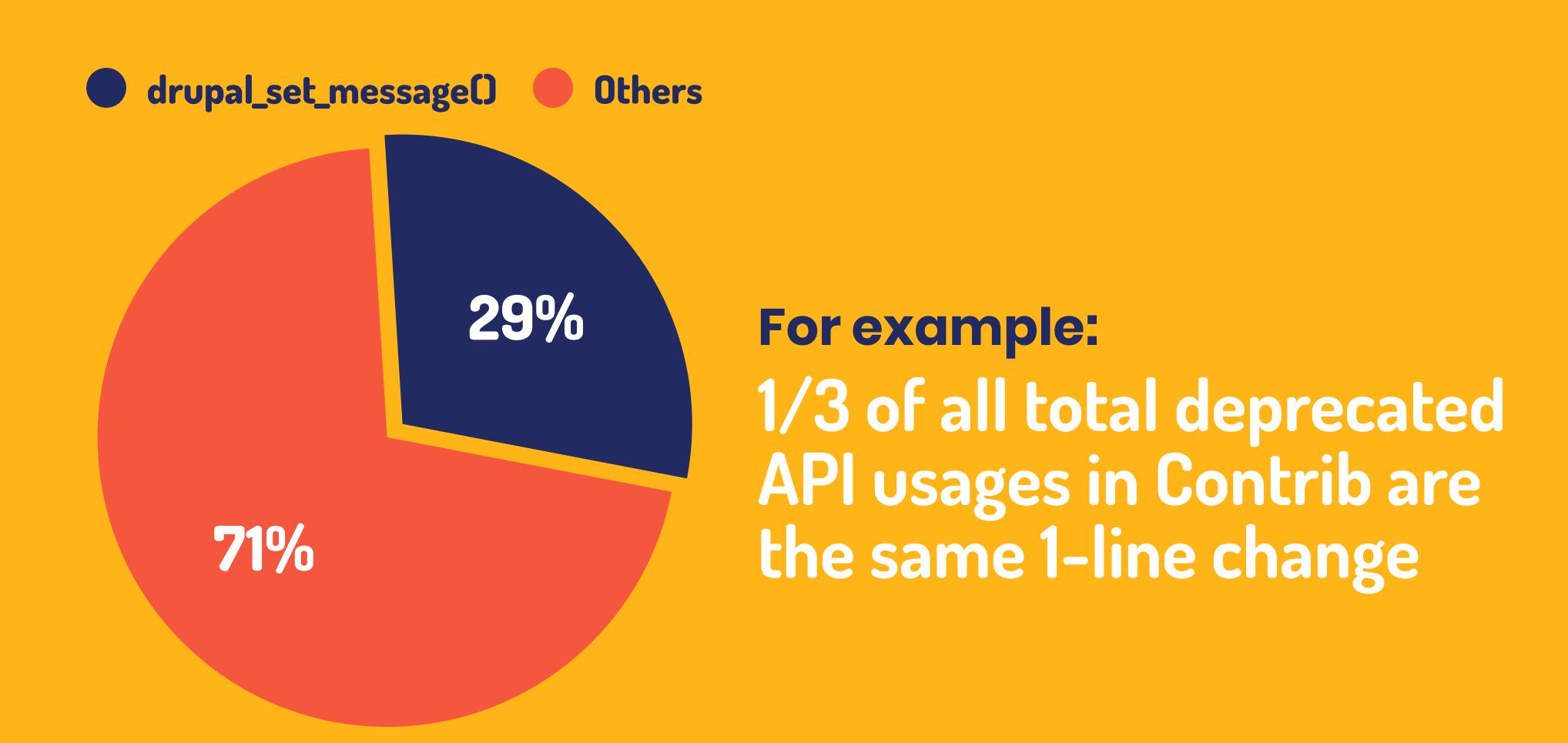


16% of top 200 modules are Drupal 9 ready

When we released Drupal 8, almost no modules were ready



Most deprecations are easy to fix!



Drupal 7 → Drupal 8 VS. Drupal 8 → Drupal 9

Re-write modules Minor updates to modules Start after 8 release Start now, months before release Incremental updates (testable in Drupal 8) Big bang update

Help upgrade modules to Drupal 9

Remove use of deprecated code from your projects

All deprecated APIs are defined and the tools are available, so you can work on Drupal 9 compatibility now, 8 months ahead of the release!

Work on removing deprecated APIs from core itself

Remove deprecated code from the Drupal 9 branch.
